TO BE CONDUCTED ON MAY 4, 2010

Applications will be accepted until the close of business (4:30 p.m.) on the 7th day prior to the election (Tuesday, April 27, 2010) if the ballot is to be mailed to the elector; or until the close of business (4:30 p.m.) on the Friday immediately preceding the election (April 30, 2010), if the ballot will not be mailed to the elector.

Under Colorado law, your mail-in ballot application must contain your printed name, signature, residence address, mailing address if you wish to receive the ballot by mail, and date of birth. If you do not provide all of this information, you may not receive a mail-in ballot according to the rules established by the Secretary of State.
