SBC Long Distance - Voice

SBC Long Distance 1+ Outbound is a long distance calling service that provides direct dial, outbound service for voice, data, fax, or video traffic. 1+ Outbound offers a simple, seamless solution for your customer's existing needs and allows your customer to upgrade and support new business initiatives through a variety of services and pricing plans. High Volume Calling Plans begin at \$50 per month.

SBC Long Distance Calling Card is an alternately billed long-distance service that allows your customer to place calls when they are away from their business phone. Calling Card lets your customer place calls from most telephones that allow toll-free access. Calling Card gives your customer the freedom to make a call no matter where they are.

SBC Long Distance - Voice

SBC Long Distance Dedicated Voice Access (DVA) is a digital access service that provides dedicated access to voice trunking. DVA improves the efficiency and economy of long distance service based on your customer's call volume and contract term. DVA will help your customer streamline their incoming and outbound calling and lower their costs.

DVA can be scaled to fit the size of your customer's operations. The six- and 12-pack options—only available with SBC T1 Integrated Access Service (IAS), provided by SBC Telecom—enable your customer to handle six or twelve simultaneous calls, respectively. Our DS1 DVA option permits 24 simultaneous calls, and if your customer chooses ISDN PRI with DS1, they can incorporate advanced calling features into their communications center. The DS3 DVA package allows 672 simultaneous calls.

All-digital DVA services run at 384 Kbps (6-pack), 768 Kbps (12-pack), 1.544 Mbps (DS1) and 44.7 Mbps (DS3). We assign voice trunk groups to the dedicated access facilities based on your customer's requirements in these bandwidths. Your customer controls or designates the trunk group arrangement, whether it is the originating outbound voice or terminating toll-free service. The DVA transport facility handles calls made on these voice trunks, bypassing the local switch. Your customer can designate overflow calls to other trunk groups or to switched access.

Toll-Free Service encourages your customer's customers to keep coming back by providing them with a cost-free method to contact your customer. Toll-Free Service also helps your customer expand their business by encouraging new customers to call.

International Toll-Free Service (ITFS) is also available. ITFS expands toll-free service to calls originating from foreign countries.
